Bowler's Code of Conduct

REPRESENTING THE CLUB

Members are deemed to be representing the Chermside Bowling Club (the Club) in any of the following situations:

- (a) As part of any representative team on behalf of the Club;
- (b) When wearing the club uniform or other dress that identifies the person as a member of the Club;
- (c) When attending any function on behalf of the Club; and
- (d) When playing bowls at any level of the game, including practice and social games.

When representing the Club members are expected to do so in the spirit of the game and abide by this Code before, during and after games.

The following are examples (but not a complete list) of unacceptable actions and are violations of this Code:

- (a) Use of offensive language
- (b) Abuse, threats or intimidation of Club Committee, staff, game officials or selectors in the course of their duties.
- (c) Players are expected to keep alcohol consumption to an acceptable level to ensure their contribution to the teams performance will not be impeded.
- (d) Refusal or failure to comply with laws relating to smoking and alcohol consumption.
- (e) Any forms of physical, verbal, mental, emotional and/or sexual abuse or discrimination on the basis of gender, creed, sexual orientation, disability or ethnic origin of a member or visitor to the Club.
- (f) Wilful damage to the Club or the Clubs property
- (g) Bringing the Club or any other member of the Club or the sport of lawn bowls into disrepute.

MANAGEMENT OF ALLEGED CODE VIOLATIONS

If any member is perceived to have violated this Code of Conduct, the Disciplinary Committee of the Club will initially investigate the allegations as per Constitution.

Any members whose actions are considered in breach of this Code may, after being heard, be reprimanded, suspended, or expelled from the Club.
