Congratulations to this year's winners, Kevin Hewitt, Mark Lee, John Staley and Mick Ryan.


Commiserations to Neal Shore, Shane Hinsch, Glenn Coward and Geoff Kirton who proved worthy in making the winners work for the win.

DISABILITY ACTION PLAN FOR CLUB CHERMSIDE

Club Chermside was recently invited to take part in some specially devised training on access and inclusion, which will help the Club to develop its own "disability action plan".

Michael McMahon and Janette Kennedy went along to Everton Park Bowls Club to participate.

The Australian Human Rights Commission recommends that every community facility has a well-thought-out disability action plan, to remove barriers to people with disabilities who might like to take part in activities there.

Such a plan can also widen the market for the services that a community facility provides. The training was delivered by Spinal Life Australia on Wednesday 13 September 2023, from 10:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. at Everton Park Bowls Club.

Council has engaged Spinal Life Australia to provide the training. Spinal Life has extensive experience in delivering disability awareness training through innovative programs such as "The Realistic Race", an immersive workshop that provides participants with firsthand perspective on the experiences of individuals living with disabilities. The session held on 13 September will be followed by workshops with each of the participating lessees to develop their disability action plans, on dates to be agreed.








Club Chermside would like to acknowledge one of its members - Jarred Hill, for arranging the supply of timber to repair the supports on the seats around our greens.


























Editor's Note:
